Dear Customer:

To the best of my knowledge, none of the minerals identified as Conflict Minerals (Tin, Tantalum, Tungsten, or Gold or any other derivatives of columbite-tantalite (coltan), cassiterite, or wolframite), are intentionally part of the formulation or intentionally added during manufacture of PLENCO thermoset molding compounds.

Additionally, to the best of my knowledge, none of the minerals identified as subject to Extended Minerals Reporting (Cobalt, Copper, Graphite, Lithium, Mica, or Nickel), that may be used in a limited number of PLENCO thermoset molding compounds, are sourced from Conflict-Affected and High-Risk Areas (CAHRAs).
